Ok, the leaders are teeing off and I have ripping to do while I watch!



I heard several attendees comment on his amazing teaching style and how they would like Michael to teach additional workshops for us! Thank you, Michael, for sharing your amazing quilts and workshop with us!

I sure hope you are planning to join us at our Guild meeting on April 13th for our Charity Night. Joanne Krepps has been busy planning how we can best assist her. I understand she has plenty of pillow stuffing for us to use in the cancer pillows and even has some newly designed pillows for us to stuff. Not only do we get to do something wonderful for the community as we help Joanne with the Guild's charity projects but we get to visit with our fellow Guild members as well. Thanks Joanne for making it easy for us to do something good for others.

Did you happen to check out the pictures on our Guild web page or our new Facebook page to see pictures from our program, show and tell and even from one of the round robin challenge teams that began last year? (Thanks Tom and Cathy for posting those for all to see.) It was fun to see how each member of the round robin team added another border to create a lovely quilt top. I happened to be part of that team and was awed by the creativity and inspiration from my other team mates. It definitely challenged me to think outside of my comfort zone and made me look at center blocks and borders differently. If you have a chance to participate in one of these round robin exchanges in the future, I would encourage you to do so. If you do not know about our Facebook site I would also encourage you to contact Cathy Kropp as she has been busy establishing a Facebook page for our Guild.

You will want to mark your calendar and plan to attend our Guild program on Thursday, May 11th, when Trish Stuart of "Trish Stuart Designs" in Emory, Texas will be presenting a trunk show and lecture "Color Theory, Choosing Colors, Values and Fabrics." Trish's love affair of fabric, fibers and fun has kept her busy for years. Growing up sewing clothing Trish stumbled into quilting when a friend needed more fabric and she walked into her first quilt shop. Immediately hooked she designed her first quilt. Compelled to share the passion and fun she shared the pattern with others, started teaching and it blossomed into 12 books and over 150 patterns, teaching nationally/internationally, creating training videos, being a guest on television shows and being invited to be a Sewing Star for both Pfaff and Viking. Her passion for sharing her ideas on how to combine and create has kept her busy exploring and teaching nationally/internationally since 1990. She believes in sharing the madness and laughter with as many people as possible. To that end, Trish will be our guest for our program on May 11th and then will teach a workshop on Saturday, May 13th.

I am taking sign-ups for Trish's workshop where she will teach us how to create our own happy garden of funky wool flowers in this contemporary wool wall hanging. The background will be a hand-painted batik. We will learn the ins and outs of successfully machine stitching wool to a batik foundation. In addition, we will explore how to further embellish our wall hanging. This workshop is designed to master machine applique and then take it to the next level! Trish is offering to have kits available for the workshop if there is enough interest in purchasing one. I will need to know if you are taking the workshop and will be purchasing a kit or providing your own fabrics in April so Trish has time to prepare the kits for our workshop. Trish will be bringing an array of background fabrics and supplies if you want to supplement your own fabrics and build your own kit.

Check out our Alamo Heritage Quilt Guild 2017 calendar to see what else we have planned for this year. I hope you are able to join us for some of those events. Also, please send me any suggestions for next year's programs and workshops since often speaker's calendars are booked well in advance. I could not pull this all together without your support and suggestions – please keep them coming!


