

The monthly meeting of the Alamo Heritage Quilt Guild board was called to order by President Carole Van Buren at 6:03pm on Monday, September 3rd, 2012.

Second Vice-President Jackie Ledford said she still had some vacancies for Trish Stuart's workshop and was working to fill them. She told us what arrangements she had made for Trish during her visit to our guild next week. Jackie is continually working on planning programs for next year, and gave us some status reports on those. She said at next week's meeting she will give an explanation of the Chinese Auction scheduled for our October meeting, for those who have never attended ours before.

The librarian reported that there are several new fiction series with a theme of quilting in our library. She continues to process the library items - fiction, how-to books, DVDs, and miscellaneous items - so that they can be posted on our guild website.
