And once again, show and tell was spectacular. So many beautiful and inspiring projects were shared. We have some very talented people in our Guild to inspire and challenge all of us.

You will not want to miss this month's program on Thursday, May 12th at 7:00 p.m. when Cathy Kropp, paper piecing extraordinaire and one of our Guild members, will do a trunk show and demonstration on paper piecing. Did you happen to see Cathy's three samples of her project "A Wreath for All Seasons" table topper or wall hanging that I showed last month at our Guild meeting? Cathy wanted to show us the possibilities we can create using her pattern and techniques during the workshop she will conduct for the Guild on Saturday, May 14th from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. It is amazing how, with different color choices or using an outer border or making the topper square or an octagon shape, each one looked so very different. It is not too late to sign up for the workshop and hope you will be able to join us.

In June Kimberly Jolly from the Fat Quarter Shop in Manchaca (located 10 miles southwest of downtown Austin for those of us not familiar with all of the little towns in Texas) will do a trunk show featuring quilts from the "It's Sew Emma" books and patterns. She will also have items for sale.

And then in July, mark your calendars and plan to join us as Marcia Henry from Dickinson, TX will be presenting "A Modern Quilt" trunk show and demonstrate how to use the Quick Curve Ruler to make these quilts. If you did not have a chance to see Marcia's sample, "Metro Twist" quilt that I brought to our Guild meeting last month, I will have it again next month. This is the quilt we will be creating during her workshop (Saturday, the 16<sup>th</sup> of July). It is not too early to sign up for the workshop.

And don't forget if you would like to be entered on an" interest list" to participate in the round robin challenge teams, just let me know. We will launch another team when we have 5 people signed up. We already have three complete teams formed. I think we can have a lot of fun with our round robin challenge! 


