PROGRAMS

You will not want to miss this month's Guild meeting on Thursday, November 9th either as Janie Alonzo, a certified Sue Pelland instructor from Zo-Ray Creations in Austin, Texas, will be doing a lecture/trunk show for us. Janie's trunk show, "Fast and Fabulous," features quilts made with the Leaves Galore applique template set. Janie will also have books, templates and other goodies for sale on Thursday night so you may want to bring a little spending money to the meeting.

Janie will also be conducting a workshop, "Leaves Galore Techniques" on Saturday, November 11th. I am taking sign-ups for the workshop now. For those who have not already ordered a pre-fused kit, you will want to fuse your own applique fabrics before the workshop. Janie shared that in order to get the most from the workshop, it helps to have the applique fabric fused before class. In addition, the background material has to be prewashed. (For those of us who preordered the complete kit, Janie has done the hard work for us so we do not need to worry about those instructions. For those that ordered the fused applique kit only or those providing all your own fabric, you will want to prewash your background material too.) I am excited about Janie's program as we saw some lovely examples of the shapes you can make using the template in her booth at the Greater San Antonio Quilt Guild Show. In a recent email Janie shared that she been busy working on new samples too!

At our Guild meeting I will also be taking signups for Michael Young's "Diamonds are Forever" workshop which will be held on Saturday, January 13, 2018. You will not want to miss out on learning Michael's techniques to create your own beautiful quilt. Don't miss the chance to take a workshop from Michael as those Guild members who attended his "One Block Wonder" quilt workshop this past year can attest. The cost of the workshop is \$35.00.

Have you started looking for your "to die for" yard of fabric for the Guild's Christmas Party on Thursday, December 14th? Have you been thinking about making your favorite dish to bring to the party? Our 1st Vice President, Linda Clark, has a fun evening planned for us in addition to our usual potluck Christmas party. I am definitely looking forward to seeing what she has in store for us!

ACCOMODATIONS: Our accommodations are 2 bedroom condos; with 4 people to a condo. 1 bedroom has 2 queen beds and the other bedroom has 2 twin beds. Parking is close to each condo, and most things are handicap accessible. They have a lovely pool and tennis courts if you want to relax and play. If you have specific needs please let me know at time of sign up, also any special dietary requirements.

MEALS: Hearty meals will be served in the dining room starting with dinner at 6:00 the day of your arrival, either Thursday or Friday. Three meals will be served daily, other than Sunday, which will be only breakfast and lunch.


