She graduated from both eighth grade and high school in Navasota as valedictorian. She graduated from Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas, with a bachelor's in education cum laude with a concentration in music. She married C.W. Walker and they had two children, Stephen Wesley Walker and Shannon Walker. Rickie taught elementary school in San Antonio, Randolph AFB and Fort Knox, Kentucky. She taught elementary music in Greenville, Texas. She earned her Master of Education in Guidance and Counseling from East Texas State University, now Texas A & M Commerce. She began her counseling work at Greenville ISD and then spent a year teaching first grade in Edgewood ISD. She continued her counseling in East Central ISD at Oak Crest Middle School and Heritage Middle School for 23 years. She married John W. McGinty in 1991. They enjoyed traveling, canoeing and kayaking. John lovingly cared for Rickie in her final illness. After her retirement from education in 2006, she took up quilting and worked part time at Seventh Heaven Quilt Shop. Rickie was an accomplished painter who specialized in watercolors. She also became a member of the Assistance League of San Antonio where she was manager of their thrift store for two years. Rickie is survived by husband John, her two children, three stepdaughters, eleven grandchildren and two great-grandsons.

In order to provide sufficient time to the presenters at the meeting, the Board decided to try something new. The Show & Tell portion will be held after the presentation.

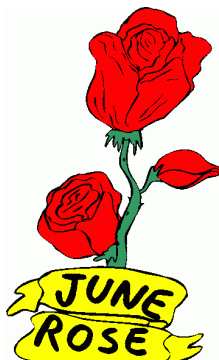
BERNINA PRESSER FEET & ACCESSORIES

Thank you. **Well we waited a year to get Jen Eskridge** of ReannaLily Designs as a lecturer at our guild. I think it was well worth the wait! I actually took a stab at free motion quilting on a quilt for my daughter. It worked out great and I plan on doing more before it is finished. Remember Jen is teaching these techniques at Patty's Sewing Center for those who want to get a hands-on experience with these techniques. This month our Program will be "30 years of Mother Daughter Quilts" by Debby Walters and her daughter, Kim. We have 11 people signed up for the 2-day Workshop, Designing with Strips n Curves by Debby Walters (using Louisa Smith's method). The workshop starts on Friday, June 14th with finalizing and sewing our strata in preparation for the Strips n Curves Class on Saturday. Friday isn't a mandatory class, you can still take the 1-day workshop on Saturday at our usual location at Holy Trinity Church. But you will need to come with your Strata ready! Find me at the June meeting to discuss further/sign up!

In **July**, we have a Program by **Jackie Hillman** titled **"The Goose is Loose on the Ranch."** She will show us her unique use of Flying Geese. Her **workshop on Saturday, July 13th, will be making the Disappearing Flying Geese Table runner** using her technique! We will continue taking signups for this workshop at the June meeting. There are 3 different table runners you can make. We don't all have to choose the same one. Look for Photos of the table runners and kit requirements in this newsletter. Feel free to use your own fabrics or she has kits available if you don't want to hunt for fabric!

You all are our primary source of suggestions for great programs and workshops. Please feel free to text, email or talk to me about any ideas you have for 2020 programs and workshops since often speaker's calendars are booked well in advance.

Skill level Scale

Beginner - Student has no sewing, piecing or quilting experience

Experienced Beginner - Student has attended beginner quilt making class or equivalent

Intermediate- Student has completed a few quilt tops and is ready to "expand" their skills; confident piecer.

Advanced – Student has more experience with piecing and finishing quilts

Workshop fees – Same day as lecture (half day) \$250, One Day \$450.00; Two Day \$650

Maximum of 20 students.

Disappearing Flying Geese Table Runners (Horizontal Split) (Pattern \$7.00 includes sales tax)

Length: half to full day (5-6 hours)

Skill Level: Experienced Beginner to Intermediate

With all three being available for the same class, students can choose which one of the three table runners they wish to make.

Precut kits available for \$37 but are not required for the class (includes fabric for top and pattern). Kits can be brought to the lecture/workshop and students can choose on site.
