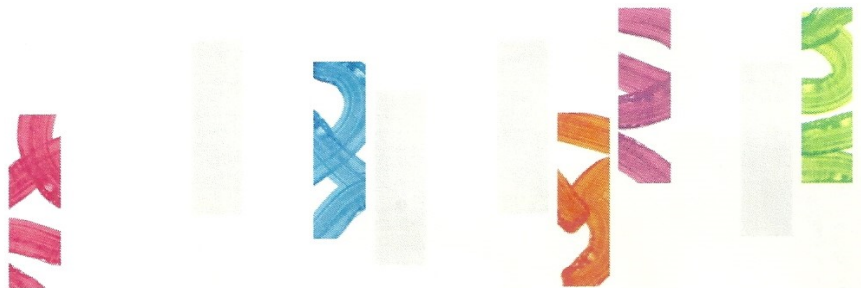

BINDING CLASS SUPPLY LIST

MJ Fielek

Machine in good working order and a full bobbin

(So you don't take time in class to wind bobbin)

FABRIC 2 different colors -----1/4 yard each of fabric width of fabric, not fat quarters.....just use something in you stash that you don't really like.

Long ruler for cutting binding, cutting mat & rotary cutter.

Small ruler with 45 degree angle

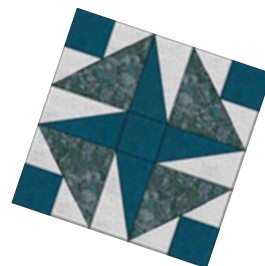
Fabric marking pen (pencil, water erase or heat erase)

Binding clips

Hand sewing needle and thimble if you use one.

Will need ironing stations to support the number of people in class.

You will receive a prequilted piece of fabric and instructions for applying binding using a different method on each side.

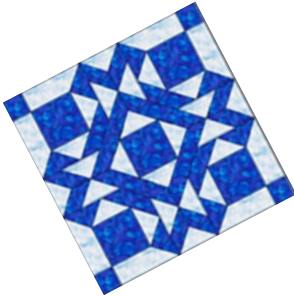

The El Paso Quilters Association posted on Facebook a request for help with their project to provide lap quilts to those affected by the shooting in their town. The directions can be found on the next page.

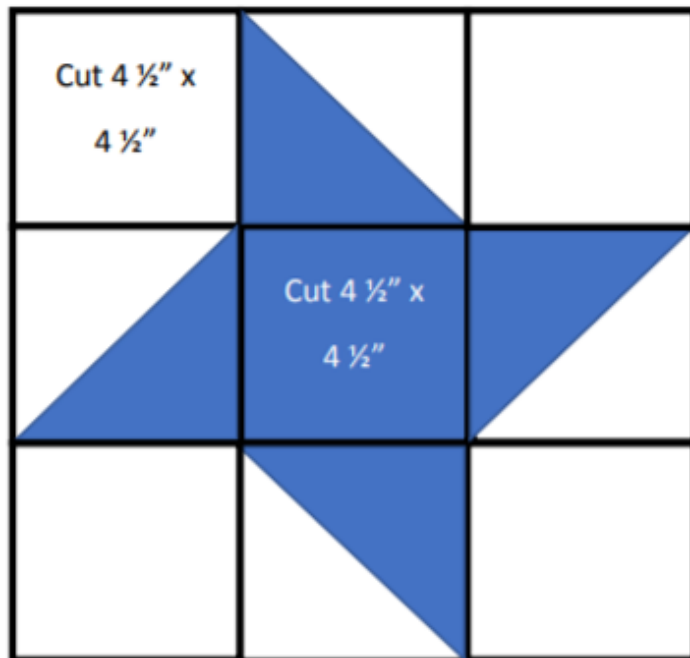
Personally, I was drawn to donate blood but was afraid I would be denied. Instead, I made four blocks and mailed them as soon as I could.

Friendship Stars for El Paso



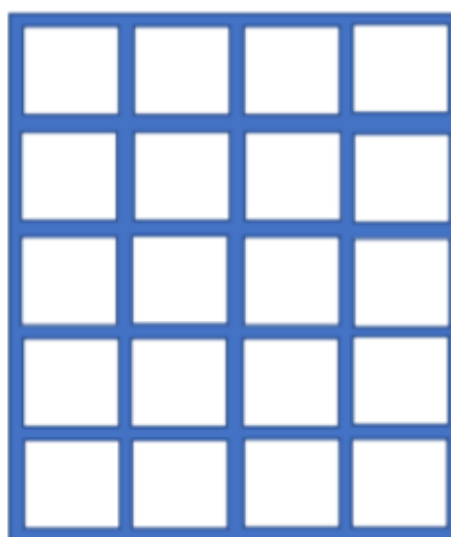
Half Square Triangles- Cut 5" square in half diagonally from color and background white.
Sew and trim to 4 1/2".

If you would like to make a completed quilt:
We are looking for lap sized quilts.

3x4 blocks with 3 1/2" sashing and 5" border



4 x 5 blocks with 2 1/2" sashing only
