

Jackie Asbill has been making quilts since the 1970's and is a Professional Quilter. She is a pattern designer and a teacher. This program will start our journey into the new quilting year.

Our **February 13th Meeting** Guest Speaker is **Betsy Chutchian**. She will be talking about the 19th Century Patchwork Quilt Divas and their quilts. The **April 9th Meeting** will be Charity Night. JoAnne Krepps and the Charity Bee will have lots of projects for us to work on. It is a great opportunity to sit with new people and get to know them!






