Why Do Quilts Cost So Much?

Cost of materials, construction & finishing for a 65" x 65" Throw Quil

Materials for the Throw Quilt

Fabric for quilt top

Regular Quilt Shop Price 6 yds @ \$14.00 yd = \$84 5 yards Backing @ \$14.00 yd = \$70

72" x 90" 80/20 Batting = \$19.99

Pattern @ \$15.00 Thread for Piecing \$9.00

Total cost Regular Price \$206.74 (not including sales tax and mark up)

Box Store or Quilt Shop Sale Price

6 yds @ \$10.00 yd. (sale price) =\$60 5 yds @ \$10.00 yd. (sale price)= \$50.00 72"x 90" Batting (sale price)=\$12.00

5/8 yd Binding @ \$14.00 yd = \$8.75 5/8 yd Binding @ \$10.00 yd. (sale price) = \$6.25

Pattern (sale price) \$10.00 Thread for Piecing (sale price) \$5.40

Construction

Labor based on \$25 an hour. Average price for a seam stress is \$28 an hour An experienced quilter with tools.

Tools: rotary cutter, new blade, rulers, straight pins, scissors, seam rippers, iron, etc. 50 hours @ \$25 hr. = \$1250 50 hours @ \$25 hr. = \$1250

Quilt Sandwich 3 hrs. @ \$25 hr. = \$75 Quilt Sandwich 1 1/2 hrs. @ \$25 = \$37.50

Quilting on a Long Arm Machine (all overedge to edge)

4225 sq in x \$.03 = \$126.75 (corrected) 4225 sq. in. x \$.03 = \$126.75 Thread for Quilting \$15 Thread for Quilting (sale price) \$9 Less Time Price: \$ \$1423.25

Total for Regular Price = \$1466.75

Finishing

2 hours @ \$25 hr. = \$50 Attaching the binding by hand 10 hours x \$25 hr. = \$250

Total Finishing Cost = \$300 Total Cost of Quilt = \$1973.49 Making the binding 1/2 an hr. @ \$25 hr. = \$12.50 Attaching the binding by machine 1 hr. @ \$25 hr. = \$25.00

> Less Time by Machine = \$37.50 Total Cost Sale/Less Time = \$1604.40

A handy hint for those who enjoy quilting or stitching by hand -

Thread a whole packet of needles onto your spool of thread- one right after the other, then knot the end. All of your needles will stay on the spool.

As you need one, pull one needle with the length of thread needed and cut and tie another knot on the thread still attached to the spool.

You will get fewer knots and tangles in your thread and will not have to stop for a while to thread a needle.




