

# Supply Sheet for **Borders Galore Wall Hanging**

Approximate size : 38" x 38"

*Taught by Winnie Fleming*

Bring the following to class:

Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies

Thread to match background fabric

Rotary cutter and mat

Long and short rulers (Omnigrd w/45 lines preferred)

4" or 6" Bias square or Omnigrd square ruler

Tape measure

Calculator

Pen or pencil

Iron

**FABRIC:** the sample used blacks (DARKS), whites (LIGHTS) and hot pinks (ACCENT)

Center Block - (A) Accent (small star) - 1/3 yard

(B) Dark (lg star and binding) -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

(C) Light background - 1/8 yd

(D) 1<sup>st</sup> Border - Accent stripe - 1/8 yd

(E) Dark - setting triangles - 1/3 yard

(F) 1<sup>st</sup> Pieced Border (Dark triangles and floater border) -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

(G) Accent - squares -  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard

(H) Light Background (both pieced borders) -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

(I) 2<sup>nd</sup> Border - small Dark stripe -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

(J) 2<sup>nd</sup> Pieced Border - Dark (flying geese) - 1/3 yard

(K) Outer Border stripe - 1  $\frac{3}{8}$  yards (if a stripe isn't available, a large print works great)

(L) Backing - 1  $\frac{1}{3}$  yards

(For a very productive workshop, cut all strips and squares ahead of time.)

## Borders Galore Wall Hanging Center Star Instructions

Make 1 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfinished) block BEFORE class.

### 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square

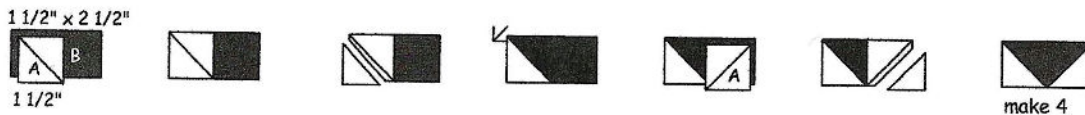
cut 1 - 1 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 1 1/2" squares

Fabric B - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 2 1/2" squares, 4 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles and 4 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

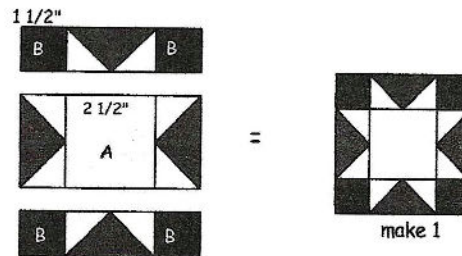
Fabric C - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 2 1/2" squares and 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

### 2. Piecing Order:

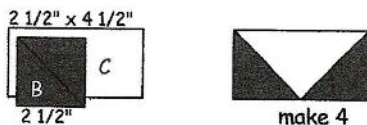
Make 1 - 4" finished (4 1/2" unf.) center variable star. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 8 A 1 1/2" squares. Place an A square over one corner of B 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch ON the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from seam and press outward toward small triangles. Make 4. Repeat by placing another A 1 1/2" square over the opposite corner of B (pay attention to the direction of the diagonal line according to the drawing). Stitch ON the line, trim 1/4" from seam and press outward. Make 4.



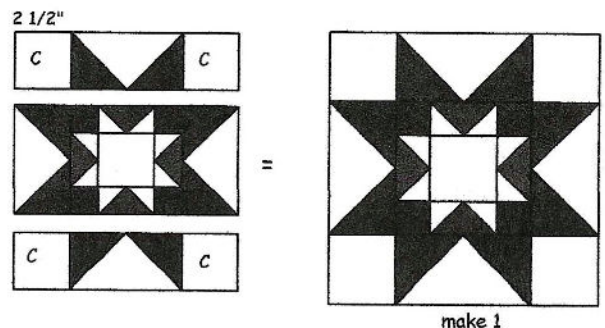
Sew block together by rows according to the diagram:



Next, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 8 B 2 1/2" squares. Place a B 2 1/2" square over one corner of C 2 1/2" x 4 1/2", right sides together and match raw edges. Repeat same sew 'n flip technique and make 4 large star tip units.



Then make 1 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) center star by sewing rows together according to the diagram.



## Borders Galore Wall Hanging

Pre-cutting information (all strips are cut from selvage to selvage)



- Fabric A - cut 1 - 2 ½" square  
Cut 8 - 1 ½" squares  
Border - cut 4 - 1 ¼" strips
- Fabric B - cut 1 - 2 ½" strip, subcut 8 - 2 ½" squares, 4 - 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles and 4 - 1 ½" squares  
BINDING - cut 4 - 2 ¼" strips
- Fabric C - cut 1 - 2 ½" strip, subcut 4 - 2 ½" squares and 4 - 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles
- Fabric D - border - cut 2 - 1 ½" strips
- Fabric E - cut 2 - 8" x 8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles ☒
- Fabric F - Floater Border (to be figured in class)  
Cut 1 - 3 3/8" strip, subcut 9 - 3 3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 36 triangles ☒
- Fabric G - cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 36 - 2" squares
- Fabric H - cut 1 - 3 3/8" strip, subcut 11 - 3 3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 44 triangles ☒  
Cut 4 - 2" strips, subcut 68 - 2" squares
- Fabric I - Floater Border - (to be figured in class)
- Fabric J - cut 3 - 2" strips, subcut 32 - 2" x 3 ½" rectangles
