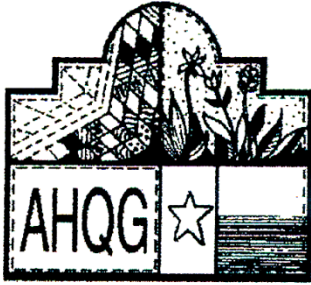

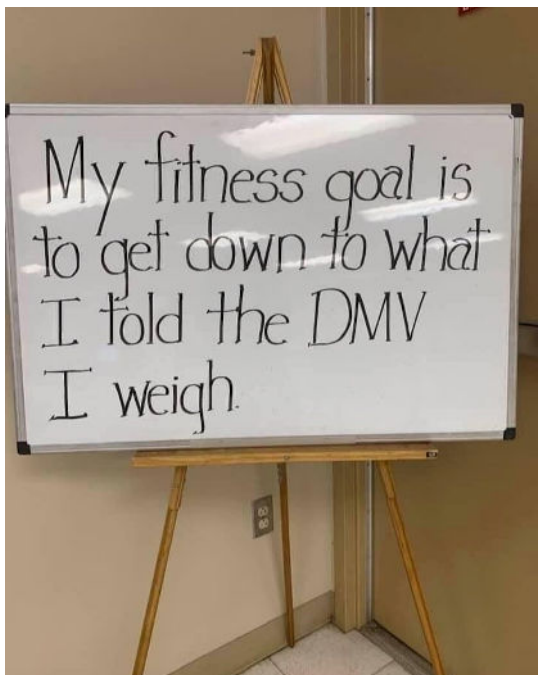

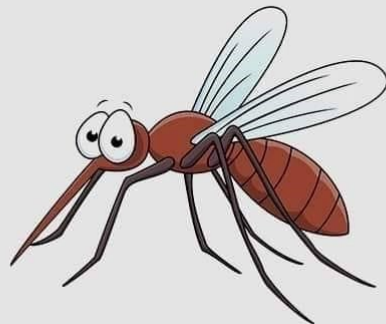

WORKSHOP INFO

The Borders Galore wall hanging will be taught by Winnie Fleming and will give you a lot of information that you can use on your other quilting projects. You will learn to pre-cut mitered borders and learn to use border stripe fabric. You'll learn a lot about precision piecing and making pieced borders. Winnie also has a formula for fitting the pieced border to the quilt that's very helpful, accurate and works every time.

Come to the workshop with your center star made and pieces cut for the border in order to get the most out of class time.

As you are donating quilts for the auction, please help us by identifying the pattern, size and name of the quilt. Please see Janet Daniel at the guild meeting for information.

We still have tops in need of quilting. If you have time to help with quilting, please come and see us at the meeting. We have several quilters that have volunteered to complete the binding process.

As you can see, we are accepting quilted quilts, pieced or applique tops and special items (quilted totes, dolls, etc).

Also, at this time we are in desperate need of 2.5" strips in black and white or red, white and blue strips AND 5" squares any color!!

We'll also have a scrap bag auctioned. This is always a popular item among our scrappy quilters! If you have scraps that you just can't seem to organize or just don't want to, consider donating to our SCRAP BAG. Each auction, it seems to get heavier!

Remember our BOUTIQUE is always accepting books, quilt kits, antique quilts, quilting notions, sewing items, fabric yardage, fat quarters, layer cakes, charm packs or an assortment of fabric. If you have questions about BOUTIQUE items, please see Mona Jones.

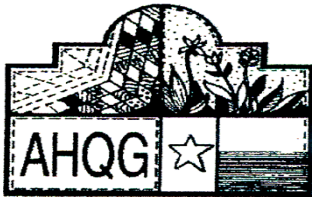
