BARN QUILT PAINTING WORKSHOP REGISTRATION CLOSED MARCH 1ST

Looking Ahead:

Program – March 12th Janet Plentl of Javibe Barn Quilts (Javibebarnquilts.com) Journey into Barn Quilts and the Hill Country Barn Quilt Trail. Janet is an artist and owner of JaVibe Barn Quilts in Marble Falls. Janet's barn quilts have been blue ribbon winners at the Burnet County fair and featured in local newspapers and magazines. To spread the joy of barn quilts, Janet formed the Hill Country Quilt Trail. This free trail encourages the public viewing and promotion of barn quilts in the Texas hill country.

BARN QUILT PAINTING WORKSHOP REGISTRATION CLOSED MARCH 1ST

Workshop – March 13th - Janet will be teaching the art form of barn quilts in a workshop. She provides ALL the supplies and **you** will provide your desired block pattern (two weeks prior to the workshop date). ACCOMODATIONS: Our accommodations are 2 bedroom condos with 4 people to a condo: 1 bedroom has 2 queen beds and the other bedroom has 2 twin beds. Parking is close to each condo and most things are handicap accessible. There is a lovely pool, and tennis courts if you want to relax and play. **If you have specific needs, please let me know at the time of sign up, will try to accommodate special dietary requirements.**

MEALS: Hearty Meals will be swerved in the dining room starting with dinner at 6:00 on Thursday. Three meals will be served daily, other than Sunday, which will be only breakfast and lunch. Beside the meals, morning and afternoon snacks will be served. Tea, coffee, and water will be always available. 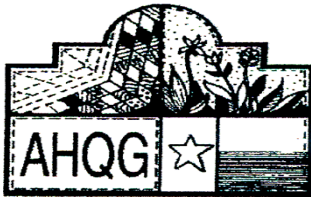
