# FUNNIES



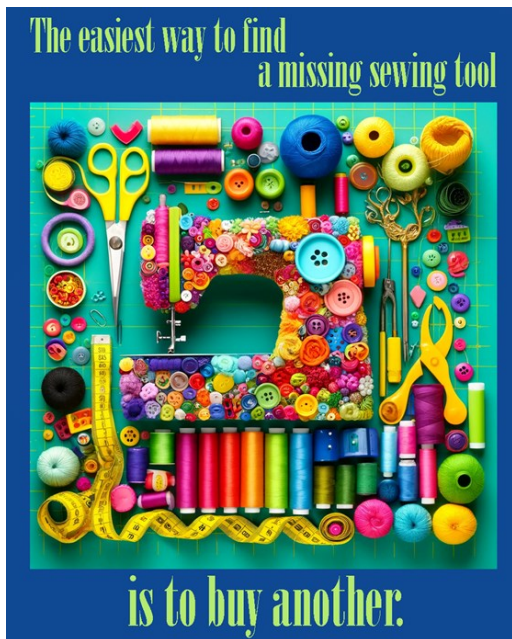
