
can Quilts." I have heard this is wonderful. Hope you can make it.

PROGRAMS

Our May guest speaker is Teresa Duryea Wong, who will talk about the history of Native American quilts and quilters. She was one of the first TV News camera persons, a free-lance journalist, publisher of a fine arts magazine, and worked in corporate America, until she hit the inevitable "glass ceiling". In 2013, she decided to follow her passion, and traveled to Japan every year (except during the pandemic). She is the author of 6 books, a staff writer for Quiltfolk magazine, a contributing author to Quiltcon magazine, and serves as a board member for several Quilt museums.

Our June 10th speaker is Jean Imprey, who will also be instructing our Fabulous Faces Workshop on June 11th. I am still taking sign-ups for the workshop. The workshop fee is \$35 and must be paid at the time you sign up. YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO SIGN UP FOR THE WORKSHOP AT THE JUNE MEETING.
